

Burn Ban Amendment Ordinance 2023-004

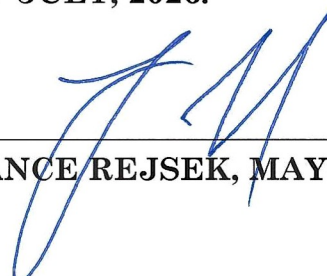
Large-Scale Land Clearing Prohibited. Notwithstanding any other provision of this ordinance, the outdoor burning of brush, trees, stumps, limbs, or vegetative debris resulting from land clearing, site preparation, construction, development, demolition, or the clearing of more than one-quarter (1/4) acre of property is prohibited within the City of East Bernard. Such materials shall be chipped, mulched, hauled to an approved disposal facility, or otherwise disposed of in accordance with applicable law.

No outdoor burning of domestic waste shall burn for more than six (6) consecutive hours. The fires shall be constantly attended until the fire is extinguished. At least one portable fire extinguisher or other on-site fire-extinguishing equipment, such as dirt, sand, or garden hose, shall be available for immediate use.

Penalty. Each day a violation continues shall constitute a separate offense.

This Amendment to the Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage, approval and publication.
